BACKGROUND

Began in 1983 as "Operation Blessing"

Incorporated as a charitable organization in 1987 and operating as Stratford House of Blessing.

We give everything away to those in need, free of charge.

GOVERNED BY:

Board of Directors (5 volunteers and 1 non-voting officer)

CO-OPERATING with agencies for Community Service: Probation, Ontario Works, High School Students

AGENCIES that refer clients to us – Children's Aid Society, Canadian Mental Health, Family Services, Public Health, Optimism Place, Emily Murphy Centre, Ontario Works, local churches, and other Social Service Organization within the community.

OPEN TO THE PUBLIC:

- Food Bank – Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday – 10:00 a.m. to Noon and 1:00 to 3:00 p.m.
- Food Bank – Home Delivery – Tuesday A.M. & P.M., Wednesday A.M. & Thursday A.M.
- Office is open Monday – Friday 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Closed for lunch from 12:15 to 12:45 pm
- Food Bank can be accessed once a month

VOLUNTEER HOURS: 3,759 volunteer hours by 120 volunteers (including one-time special event volunteers)

NEW FAMILIES USING SERVICES FOR THE FIRST TIME IN 2024: 287 (representing 548 individuals)

MONTHLY AVERAGES: Average of 53 people served per day. Average of 1,590 served per month. Average 24 new households per month. Average of 610 unhoused visits per month.

TOTAL PEOPLE PROVIDED WITH FOOD: 11,435 households were served in 2024

- Represents a total of 19,222 individuals
- 19% were children.

ESTIMATED # OF MEALS GIVEN OUT: $19,222 \times 15$ (3 meals x 5 days) = 288,330 meals

UNIQUE # OF UNHOUSED INDIVIDUALS: 7,322 individuals served
