TOTAL NUMBER OF NEW FAMILIES USING SERVICES AT SHOB FOR THE FIRST TIME IN 2021 - 184

TOTAL PEOPLE PROVIDED WITH FOOD – 4,958 households were served food

- This represents a total of 8,967 people who were provided meals

- 31% were children

ESTIMATED MEALS GIVEN OUT – 7274×15 (3 meals for 5 days) = 109,110 meals

1693×2 (2 days of food – unstable housing) = 10,158 meals
