Began in 1983 as "Operation Blessing"

Incorporated as a charitable organization in 1987 and operating as Stratford House of Blessing.

We do not sell anything; we give everything away to those in need.

GOVERNED BY:

Board of Directors (4 volunteers and 1 non-voting officer)

CO-OPERATING with agencies for Community Service: Probation, Ontario Works, High School Students

AGENCIES that refer clients to us – Children's Aid Society, Canadian Mental Health, Family Services, Public Health, Optimism Place, Emily Murphy Centre, Ontario Works, local churches, and other Social Service Organization within the community.

- Office is open Monday – Friday 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- Food Bank can be accessed once a month

VOLUNTEER HOURS: 5,445 volunteer hours by 252 volunteers

NEW FAMILIES USING SERVICES FOR THE FIRST TIME IN 2022: 233 (REPRESENTING 461 INDIVIDUALS)

TOTAL PEOPLE PROVIDED WITH FOOD: 6,372 households were served food in 2022 (1015 UNIQUE HOUSEHOLDS)

- Represents a total of 11,485 people provided with food
- 31% were children

UNHOUSED or LIVING IN HOTELS: 2545 FOOD VISITS in 2022 (ABLE TO COME AS NEEDED)

UNIQUE # OF PEOPLE UNHOUSED or LIVING IN HOTELS: 350 PEOPLE representing 175 UNIQUE HOUSEHOLDS

ESTIMATED MEALS GIVEN OUT: 11,485 X 15 (3 meals for 5 days) = 172,275 meals
(15,270 meals were for 350 unique individuals who were unhoused in our community in 2022)
